1. Take some time to look back over the year 2023. Where did you see God's faithfulness to you in the year? Either now or on your own, spend some time and ask God where he was during those times when you felt alone, or wondered if he was there?
2. Even though it is impossible to fully understand, take some time to discuss the eternity of God and then compare that to the brevity of a human life.
3. How has the length of a person's life changed for you over the years? Has that affected what you see as important in your life?
4. We often hear the phrase "hate the sin, love the sinner." How is this a good statement? How can this statement give a false impression to the sinner about God's unconditional love?
5. Establishing the works of our hands. How does what I do become work for the kingdom when my work is not ministry specific? (this is not a promise that if you give it to God, he will make you wealthy, although, it is true that God blesses our work when we give it to him) Can my everyday actions become actions for the kingdom? If so, what does that look like.
6. Successful people do not usually stumble into success, there is usually intentionality and planning which goes into to it. The same goes for a deepening and strengthening of our faith. In this time of New Year's resolutions, is there anything you would like to be intentional about in 2024 to do to grow in your faith or develop a spiritual discipline.
