The Great And Beautiful Mission

1. The believers in Antioch were worshipping the Lord. What is worship of the Lord? List as many aspects of worship as you can. When are these aspects actually worship of the Lord and when are they things we do, but are really not worship?

2. The believers in Antioch were worshipping and fasting. What is fasting? What is the purpose of fasting? How should fasting be practiced?

3. Wednesday, February 14 is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. Are there any practices of temporarily removing something from your daily life or temporarily adding something to your daily life that you should do during Lent? Are there practices that you can do as a Connect Group?

4. While the believers in Antioch were worshipping and fasting, the Holy Spirit said...

How do we hear what the Holy Spirit is saying to us?

(Take your time on this question. The answer is both simple and complex. Help one another as you discuss this.)

5. Barnabas and Saul were set apart for the work to which God called them. Every follower of Jesus has a work which God has prepared for them to do and called them to do.

What is a calling from God? How do you know what His calling is for you? Why is the calling important?

6. When Barnabas and Saul set out to do the work God called them to do, they found an open door of opportunity in the synagogues in the places they went.

What doors are open for you to begin to carry out God's calling for you?

What additional doors do you need God to open for you? (Pray together as a Connect Group asking the Lord to open these doors for you.)
