Sermon Questions

1. In John 14:6, Jesus says “I am the Way, the Truth and the Life.” The definite article in front of each means there is only one Way, one Truth and one Life. How does that compare to world’s concept of truth? How does that affect our conversations with people who say this is “my” truth?
2. Jesus said “No one comes to the Father except through me.” Does this make Christianity exclusive? How do we deal with this in a world which is all about inclusivity?
3. If Jesus is the Truth and Jesus is the Word, does that affect how we read the Bible? How do we know the Truth of Scripture?
4. What does it mean when Jesus says in verses 13 and 14 “And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.”? Does this change your view of prayer, or the intensity of your prayers?
5. What does it mean when we end a prayer “in Jesus’ name”?
6. Jesus said “Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me.” Does this really bring comfort during times when our hearts are troubled? How does believing in Jesus give peace during turbulent times?
7. Does a deeper prayer life change the answers to any of the above questions? If so, how?
