## ***Sermon Questions***

***January 21, 2024***

1. Peter had to get over the idea that he thought to be ceremonially unclean are declared clean by God. Our first response is likely that we don't see anyone as ceremonially unclean. If we are honest with ourselves are there some people or type of people whom we would rather not have in our church. This may be difficult to say out loud, but it is something we should think about.
2. Peter was told to drop all he was doing and go with the men to Caesarea. That takes a lot of faith. What if the call was to talk to the person next door? Have you ever been nudged to do something by the Holy Spirit? What was your response? Why is it sometimes hard to respond to the nudge?
3. Cornelius invited his friends to hear Peter speak. Are there people who you know whom you may consider inviting to hear the gospel.
4. Peter asked Cornelius why he asked him to come. Jesus often asked people what they wanted him to do for him. If Jesus was to ask you, "what do you want me to do for you?" What would it be?
5. Peter and Cornelius shared their stories of how God prepared them for their meeting. As you look back in your life, are there times when you can see how God prepared you to meet someone, or for a work which he has prepared for you. (Ephesians 2:10)
6. Peter was introduced to the richness of sharing how God was working in the lives of different cultures. God's Kingdom, as we see in Revelation, is made up of people from all nations and cultures. What are some of the beautiful things about worship, enjoying the presence of God, expanding your view of the greatness of God, etc. which you have learned from sharing stories of people from other nations and cultures.
