## ***Sermon Questions***

***June 9, 2024***

1. Apollos was well learned in the Scriptures, knew Jesus was the fulfillment of the Old Testament and yet had so much to learn. Discuss how many people know about Jesus, but don't "know" Jesus.
2. Apollos was a gifted speaker and created a following. Talk about how people get caught up with a "speaker" and miss out on the actual truth. Discuss how Paul didn't get jealous with someone becoming almost more influential in Corinth. How would it effect you to have someone become more noticed than you in a business you began?
3. Paul could tell there were some who didn't have the Holy Spirit. How does evidence of the having the Holy Spirit in you change how you act, who you are?
4. Aquila and Priscilla were willing to invest in Apollos and Apollos was willing to be taught. Who can you associate with more (the one investing in someone else, or the one willing to learn)? How or what can you learn from being like the other person?
5. John's baptism was one of repentance and looking forward the work of the Messiah, we look back to the work of Christ and the coming of the Holy Spirit. Discuss how baptism is both a remembrance of Christ's work and having the Holy Spirit call you to repentance, and yet it is looking forward to what the Holy Spirit will continue to do in your life.
6. Paul spent two years teaching in the public square about Christ. Living Hope spent the first 10 years meeting in a school. Are there areas in the public square where people are permitted to talk about Christ today? Are there ways in which we can take the opportunity to be a positive representative of Christ and talk about Jesus in the places of our work, or in public places?
