Sermon Questions

1. This first one is an invitation to have a different focus to your connect group this week. Rather than spending the time in discussion, you are invited to spend most, if not the entire time of connect group this week in prayer. Sunday's message saw how Jesus, in the middle of being honoured, took time to pray for the city of Jerusalem. You are invited to spend the time praying for the city of Peterborough. Pray for those in leadership, pray for the organizations which provide services for the poor and the unhoused. Pray for the spread of the gospel in Peterborough (or the local town you live in). Also take time to pray for those who you know who are not believers. Spend time in specific prayers that God may work in the hearts of them this week so they may experience Easter in a new way and may also receive the gift of our risen Saviour.
2. Jesus prays for the city of Jerusalem. If Jesus would look at the city of Peterborough, what would be included in the things for which he would specifically pray?
3. Jesus was honoured and celebrated as king when he rode into Jerusalem. How can we celebrate and honour him more in our lives and in our church?
4. There are only a few times when we see Jesus weep. One is with the death of his friend Lazarus. Now he weeps for Jerusalem. What that show us about the depth of his love for the lost? How does that compare with our compassion for the lost?
5. Jesus says, "If you, even you, had only known on this day what would bring you peace." Jesus was telling them there is a limited time until destruction will happen. In their case it was within 40 years. How much do you think about the return of Christ and that it may happen at any time?
6. Jesus prayed and wept for Jerusalem in the middle of being praised and celebrated. What can we learn from that in our lives as well as the life of our church?
